

The Book of Esther in the Time of Rembrandt Jewish Museum of New York Thursday, July 10, 2025

Sisterhood has planned a trip to the Jewish Museum in Manhattan to tour the exhibit, *The Book of Esther in the Time of Rembrandt*. The exhibit focuses on how the Biblical Book of Esther fascinated Golden Age Dutch painters and how our heroine Esther became symbolic of the national identity of the Netherlands. Debbie Golden will be our tour guide. Sisterhood previously studied with Debbie how the image of Esther evolved from ideal wife to heroine in the history of western art.

The cost of this outing is \$142 per member and \$150 per non-member payable to HZT.

This amount includes transportation to and from HZT via minibus, a light lunch at the museum's Kosher restaurant LOX, admission to the museum and gratuities for the bus driver and the restaurant staff.

The tour is limited by the museum to 20 people and spots will be reserved on a first come, first served basis.

We will depart Har Zion promptly at 8:30 AM and expect to return by 5:30 PM. We will make one pit stop on the way to New York and one pit stop on the way back.
